Israeli Chamber Project's first Florida visit

The program includes Aram Khachaturian's "Trio for Clarinet, Violin and Piano;" Paul Ben-Haim's "Songs Without Words played by Clarinet and Harp;" Camille Saint-Saëns' "Fantaisie Op. 124 for Harp and Violin;"

Robert Schumann's "Fantasy Pieces, Op. 73 for Clarinet and Piano;" and Béla Bartók's "Contrasts for Clarinet, Violin and Piano."

The Israeli Chamber Project is comprised of a quartet of award-winning musicians: Tibi Cziger, clarinetist; Sivan Magen, harpist; Assaff Weisman, pianist; and Carmit Zori, violinist.

Founded in 2008, the Israeli Chamber Project — based both in Israel and New York — brings together some of today's most distinguished musicians for chamber music concerts and educational outreach programs both in Israel and abroad.

The ensemble was created to showcase Israeli culture through its music and musicians to concert goers overseas.
