## Buzzy Brits alt-J set Miami show

### Tickets on sale for band's Oct. 1 concert in Bayfront Park.

With the final dozen shows on the spring leg of their U.S. tour this month either sold out or close, alt-J on Wednesday announced new fall dates that include an Oct. 1 concert at Bayfront Park Amphitheater in Miami.

Tickets cost \$32.50-\$49.50 and went on sale Friday at AltJ-Band.com/Live, LiveNation.com and all Ticketmaster outlets.

The buzz created by the British quartet's relentlessly eclectic atmospherics is at its peak, with a Madison Square Garden sellout on Monday and an adoring response the next night for the complicated romance of "Every Other Freckle" on "The Tonight Show With Jimmy Fallon."

Their 2014 album, "This Is All Yours," won praise across the pop-culture spectrum, with a Grammy nomination for alternative music album of the year, a No. 3 spot on Time magazine's favorite albums, and prominent shout-outs on year-end lists by Rolling Stone and Spotify.

NPR's music arbiter Bob Boilen went further, calling alt-J "simply my favorite band of the decade."

## Local water parks open doors

### Paradise Cove, Calypso Bay and other county water parks are open for the season.

We love our water parks, and now, we can spend a few more days torpedoing down those big slides or just splashing around.

Paradise Cove in Pembroke Pines will be open Thursdays and Fridays in May. In past years, the park, like the others operated by Broward and Palm Beach counties' park systems, had been open only on weekends during May.

Paradise Cove, located inside C.B. Smith Park, continues to have the highest demand of all county water parks, park manager Brian McLaughlin says. The park considered going to seven days a week this time of year, McLaughlin says, but because much of its staff consists of college students, there won't be enough personnel to operate Paradise Cove until summer break.

Last year, the park changed its food policy. Coolers are

now allowed, as long as they don't contain glass or pizza, which the park sells. This year, the park has added chicken tenders and arepas to the menu, McLaughlin says.

C.B. Smith Park is located at 900 N. Flamingo Road, in Pembroke Pines. Call 954-357-5170.

Broward's three other parks are open weekends only until June 4. Castaway Island is inside Topeekegee Yugnee Park, 3300 N. Park Road, in Hollywood. Call 954-357-8811. Tropical Splash is located at Central Broward Regional Park, 3700 NW 11th Place, in Lauderhill. Call 954-357-5401. Finally, Splash Adventure is at Quiet Waters Park, 401 S. Powerline Road, in Deerfield Beach. Call 954-357-5100. More information is available at Broward.org/Parks.

Meanwhile, the two water parks operated by Palm Beach County's Parks and Recreation department are following a weekends-only

schedule until June 5, when they will open daily. After Aug. 16, they'll revert to weekends only through Sept. 7. Go to PBCGov.com/Parks/Aquatics.

Coconut Cove, at Burt Aaronson South County Regional Park, 20130 Regional Park Drive, in Boca Raton, did not open last week during public school spring break because of renovations, but officials expect it to be open soon. Call 561-274-1140. The county's other park, Calypso Bay, is located at Seminole Palms Park, 151 Lamstein Lane, in Royal Palm Beach. Call 561-790-6160.

South Florida's largest commercial water park, Rapids Water Park in West Palm Beach, is open daily through Sept. 7 and weekends after that until Nov. 1. 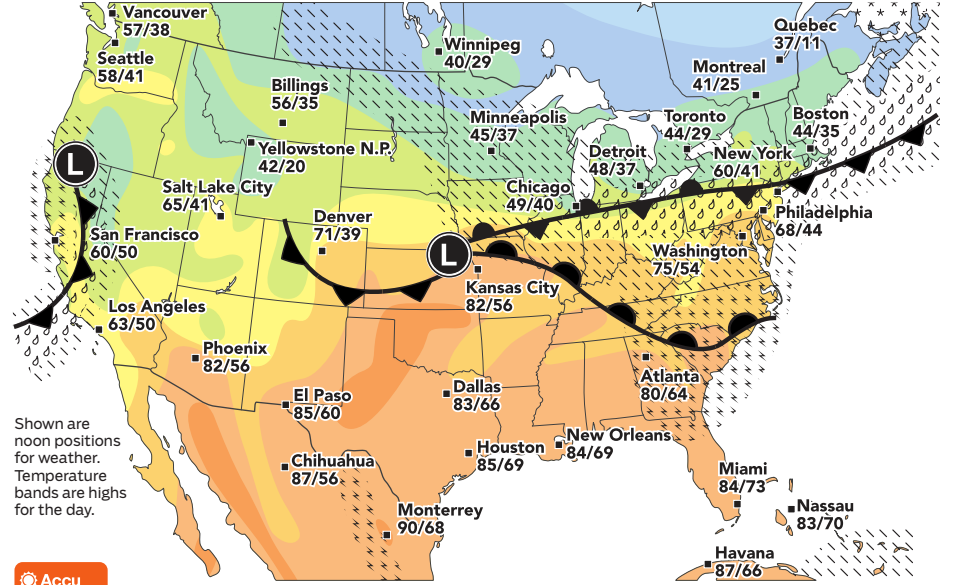
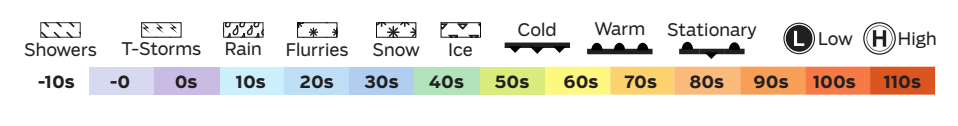
