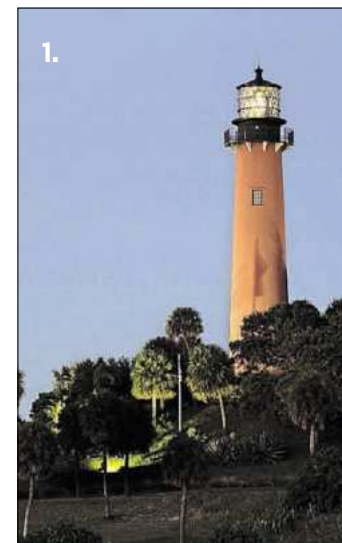
Good beer, good music, great memories
