**Violinist Sarah Chang to play at Boca festival**

Billed as the “mystery superstar violinist” until a Jan. 11 announcement, Sarah Chang will perform March 10 at the Festival of the Arts BOCA.

“I feel extremely lucky; it’s a huge deal,” said Charles Letourneau, the festival’s artistic administrator. “She’s always a success with the audience. People love her concerts. She’s just on fire on stage.”

The year’s festival, running March 2 to 12 in the covered Mizner Park Amphitheater, will include author talks and concerts, among them Sergio Mendes and Brasil 17, Branford Marsalis and a screening of “The Pink Panther” with a live orchestra. monic at age 8 in 1989. Now 36, she tours internationally and boasts more than 20 albums. She'll perform in the same concert as pianist Daniel Hsu with The Symphony Boca Raton, conducted by festival music director Constantine Kitsopoulos.

The announcement was released in agreement with the Kravis Center for the Performing Arts in West Palm Beach, where Chang performed Jan. 10 with the Prague Philharmonia.

Forum exchanged emails with the Philadelphia-born violinist about her upcoming appearance in Boca Raton.

**You're playing Bruch's Violin Concerto in G Minor at the Festival of the Arts BOCA, and you have a Bruch Concerto on your latest album. Is Max**

**Bruch your favorite composer?**

I love the Bruch Concerto, it's one of my all-time favorites and has a special place in my heart. It was my audition piece for The Juilliard School when I was 5 years old, so I have a sentimental attachment to the work. I also recorded it several years ago, coupling it with the Brahms Concerto.

**Do you know Constantine Kitsopoulos, the festival conductor?**

This will be my very first time performing in Boca and also my first time working with the maestro. I'm looking forward tremendously.

**How were you able to fit this performance into your busy tour schedule?**

I love going to new festivals, and the team that runs Boca also runs the Napa Festival, which is one of my favorite and regular

festivals. The music world is quite small and all interconnected.

**I see you've played in Orlando. Where else have you played in Florida?**

I have performed in Miami and I will also be on tour in Palm Beach, Naples, Daytona, Vero Beach, Gainesville, Panama City, etc. etc. this January. I absolutely adore Florida and I'm thrilled to be performing in Boca for the first time this year.
